

## Vocabulary: Kidnapping Investigation

<b>Alibi</b>	An excuse that someone was in a different place when a crime was committed
<b>Analyst</b>	A person who examines a piece of evidence
<b>Coroner</b>	A person who investigates a violent, sudden, or suspicious death in order to determine the cause and manner of death
<b>Evidence</b>	Anything that can prove that something, like a crime, happened
<b>Motive</b>	A reason for doing something
<b>Pathologist</b>	A medical doctor who examines a body to find the cause of death
<b>Suspect</b>	A person thought to be guilty of a crime
<b>Toxicology</b>	Science of analyzing poisons and intoxicating substances such as drugs or alcohol
<b>Unidentified</b>	Someone or Something unknown
<b>Vandalism</b>	Deliberate destruction or damage to private or public property
<b>Witness</b>	A person who saw something or someone related to a crime
